



Assessing young children with autism using the Psychoeducational Profile-3 (PEP-3)

About the PEP-3

The PEP-3 (2004) is a standardised developmental assessment for young children who may be non-verbal, have limited attention skills and poor concentration. The PEP-3 is most appropriately used with children between 2 and 7 ½ years of age. Estimates of developmental levels for lower functioning children who are older than 7 ½ years can also be obtained as well as developmental age equivalents for children functioning between 6 months and 7 years.

PEP-3 test information is drawn from two complementary sources. The first is a standardised norm-referenced scale designed to assess the development of Communication and Motor skills and the presence of Maladaptive behaviours of children suspected of having autism and other pervasive developmental disorders (PDDs). The second source is a Parent/Carer Report form, which is completed prior to the assessment of the child and asks the parent/carer to estimate the age at which their child is functioning in key developmental areas of communication, motor and social, adaptive behaviour functioning and thinking.

About the training

Participants will practice administering the PEP-3 with several typically developing children before attending day two

- Interpreting assessment results
- Discussing assessment results with parents
- Report writing
- View and discuss assessments (video)
